Audition Process

<u>Scales</u> – scales should be played with a metronome marking of 100 beats per minute. Bowing for the scale should be slur in groups of two both ascending and descending.

- 3 (three) octave C Major Scale
- 3 (three) octave e Melodic Minor Scale

<u>Etude/Technical Demonstration</u> – musicians will play **no more** than 16 bars of an etude or technical study that demonstrates their proficiency in a positive manner.

<u>Prepared Excerpts</u> – Musicians will prepare the given excerpts further down in this packet. Each excerpt has a suggested tempo, but this is flexible for sound musical interpretation. Musicians are also *strongly* encouraged to listen to **multiple recordings** of each piece to develop contextual familiarity with the selection.
